Punctuality

Students who arrive past 8.45 am, are required to sign in at the front office with a parent. The classroom register has already been completed by this time, so it is important you sign your child in manually with Mrs Armstrong.

Traffic Warden Update

On 2 June and 13 June, the first morning and afternoon survey was conducted to assess the community's needs for a Traffic Warden on Beryl Street. On both days the weather was cloudy. The assessment detected over the minimum requirement of 200 cars travelling in the area but only six pedestrians were seen to cross in this area. At least 20 pedestrians would be needed to qualify for a Traffic Warden. I encourage all families who would like to see a traffic warden installed in this area to utilise this location so that a true picture of the school community's needs may be gathered.

For the last couple of weeks, I have conducted Kindy and Pre Kindy Interviews. During this time, I gathered wonderful feedback about the school from new and existing families. Many commented on the close community and link to Parish. A lot of parents are previous students at the school and speak fondly of their time here and want their children to have the same enjoyable experience. The Bishops' Religious Literacy Assessment

At the request of the Western Australian Bishops, Year 3, Year 5 and Year 9 students in Catholic schools across Western Australia will take part in The Bishops' Religious Literacy Assessment (BRLA) from the week commencing Monday 1 August in Term Three. Students will also complete practice tests the week before.

The assessment will be accessible to students online. Students enrolled in Year 3, Year 5 and Year 9 who are following a regular classroom program are expected to participate. The BRLA provides a 'point in time' snapshot of student performance in Religious Education. Students' knowledge and understanding of the content of the Religious Education curriculum is assessed using a combination of multiple choice, short and extended response items. Students' faith is not assessed. The use of the BRLA compliments the school-based assessment programs in Religious Education.

Reports

St Lawrence Primary School uses the SEQTA parent portal for parents to access student reports for students in Pre-primary to Year 6 at the end of each semester. If you have not already done so, please log in to SEQTA to ensure you are able to access your children's report. To do this you need to go to the following site: https://stlawbal.coneqt-p.cathednet.wa.edu.au and use your current username and password.

If you know your username but have forgotten your password, please click on the "forgot your password?" link and an email will be sent to you. Please note the password reset link in the email will expire within an hour. Sacred Heart of Jesus


