Our school continues to work in partnership with WA Health as we respond to the pandemic.

This letter is to inform you that there have been confirmed COVID-19 cases in Year 1 and Year 4 at St Lawrence. The Year 1 positive case did not attend school while infectious. Close contacts of the positive case in Year 4 have been identified and we are following WA Health directives related to the recently updated processes and procedures for close contacts.

This development may make your child/children feel worried or anxious. It is important to remember that you can help your child at this time, first by listening attentively to their concerns, and then by providing some reassurance.

As a Catholic school, the safety and wellbeing of our students is always our priority as is showing care and support for all members of our community. Please refrain from sharing this news via social media and allow the school, CEWA and WA Health to communicate the facts – protecting both the privacy and dignity of all concerned.
