Dear Parents/Caregivers

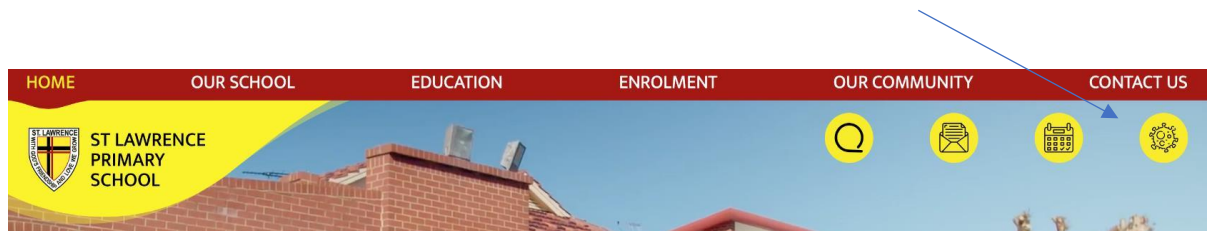
I am writing to advise you there has been a positive case of COVID-19 associated with St Lawrence Primary School.

They attended the Year Two class on Friday 25 March 2022 while infectious.

Your child is deemed a close contact by WA Health and should get tested within 24 hours. If your child tests positive for COVID-19 they will need to quarantine for 7 days. If your child has a negative test result and they are asymptomatic they will be able to attend school. Your child's test result will need to be entered on the online form on the St Lawrence Primary school website or emailed to Admin admin@stlawbal.wa.edu.au before your child is able to return to school.

Asymptomatic students identified as close contacts can continue to attend;

- school;
- care service centres;
- Outside School Hours Care (OSHC);
- school-based sporting, music, cultural training, practice or events that are organised by or take place at our school, and are held immediately before or after school; and
- travel directly between their usual place of residence and their school. Public transport should only be used if there are no other options available.
