



## **AIM**

A uniform dress code reinforces in students pride in their appearance, instils recognition of themselves as an integral part of the school community and assists in developing pride in representing their school.

## **Scope**

Year One to Six students are expected to wear a uniform as documented in the contract between parent and school at the time of enrolment. Pre-Primary students will wear a modified version of the Sport uniform.

## **PROCEDURE**

1. Summer uniform is worn in Terms One and Four, Winter uniform in Terms Two and Three. Children are to wear the school sports uniform on the day they have Physical Education or Dance.
2. At all times, children are expected to be well presented in their correct uniform. Uniforms are to be clean, pressed and in good condition. Shoes are to be well-polished.
3. Students are expected to take pride in their personal appearance and to be neatly attired. Shirts to be tucked in, shorts and skirts are to be worn sitting on the waist. Uniform dresses and skirts are to be worn at or below knee length. Each student is expected to be properly attired in full school uniform or sport uniform whilst at the school, travelling to and from school and when representing the school at external functions and events.

4. It is compulsory to wear the School Hat while participating in Physical Education classes and other outdoor lessons and excursions. A 'No Hat, No Play' rule is enforced throughout the year
5. For Health reasons, when a child's hair is of collar length or longer, it must be tied back off the face. The following regulations also apply to hair;
  - Hair to be tied back with plain navy blue or white hair elastics, ribbons, scrunchies or headbands to match summer and winter uniforms.
  - Gold, white and red accessories may be worn to match the sport uniform. Ribbons and other hair accessories must not be too large.
  - Elastics, bobby pins and side clips may be black.
  - Children's haircuts need to be conservative and appropriate to uniform expectations.
  - Radical haircuts (tracks, hawks, undercuts etc) and colour (tints, streaks, tips etc) are not acceptable.
  - Hair should be no shorter than number 2.
  - Minimal hair product/ gel may be used.
  - Fringes are to be above the eyebrows or clipped back.
  - The Principal reserves the right to decide the acceptability of hairstyles at St Lawrence school.
6. It is recommended that no jewellery be worn at school for safety and security reasons. Children are permitted to wear:
  - A watch, which includes smart watches, is permitted. Nonetheless, parents are requested to disable any functions on the watch that enable its use for purposes other than timekeeping while the student is at school. If a student uses it for any other purpose, it is treated the same as a mobile phone and must be surrendered to the front office in accordance with the Mobile Phone Procedure. Smart watches must have School Mode activated before entering the school premises.
  - A cross or Christian medal tucked under the shirt/blouse/dress are acceptable.
  - Only one pair of sleepers (small plain) or studs (small gold or silver) is permitted.
  - A Medic Alert bracelet.
7. Make-up and nail polish are not to be worn.
8. Parents/carers and staff are expected to monitor and maintain the correct wearing of the school uniform and insist on the maintenance of high standards of personal presentation.
9. If children are prevented from wearing their full uniform on any particular day, parents are required to send a note of explanation.
10. Three Year Old Kindergarten children and Kindergarten children are not required to wear school uniforms.
